We're looking forward to an amazing indoor season with our Wolves family!

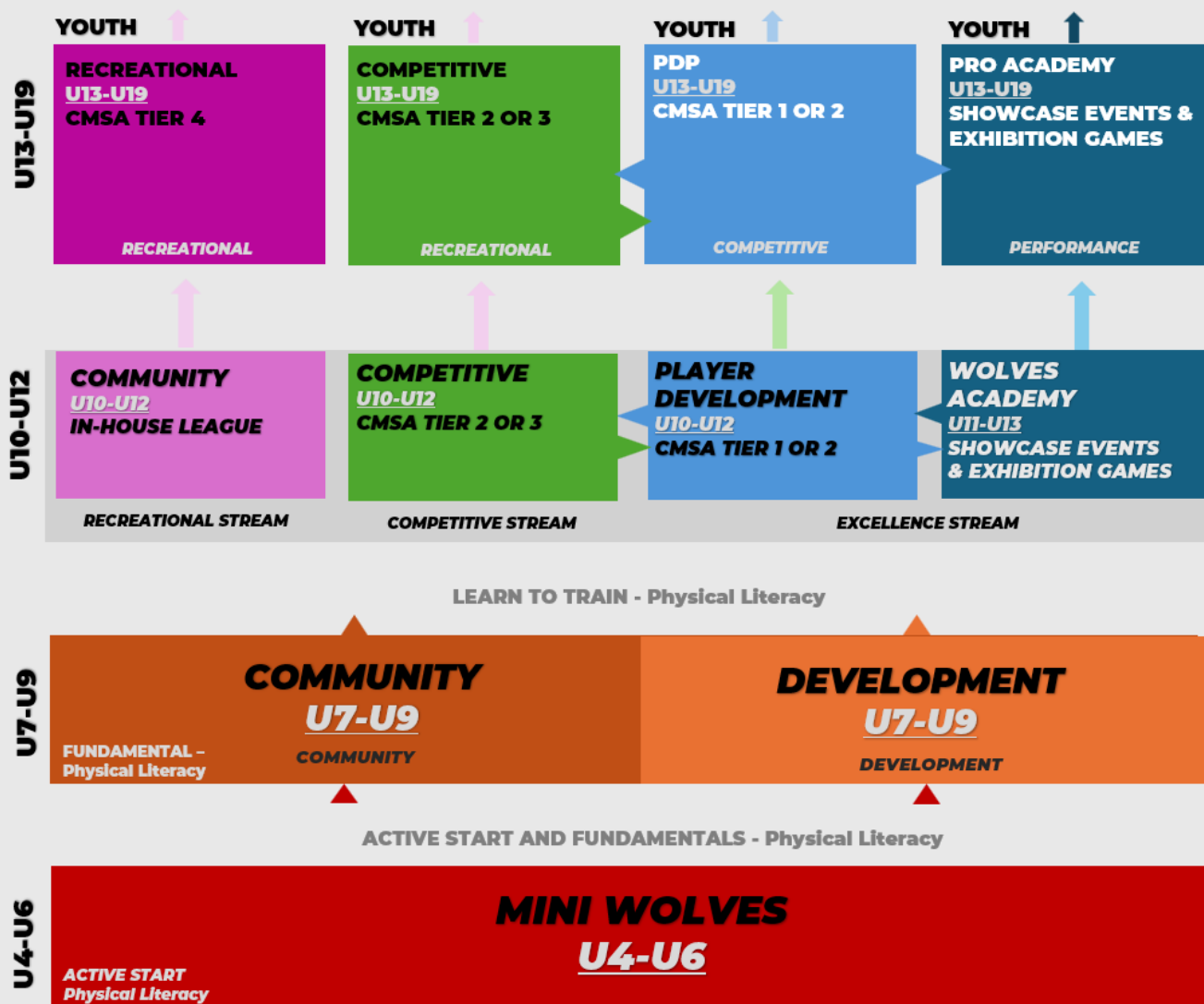


PLAYER PATHWAY CWFC

COMPETITIVE TIMELINES & TEAM FORMATION

OUTLINE

When forming teams we will consider the age, skill-level and mindset of the players, as well as gather input from parents on their desired tier level for their child. Our goal is to enter teams into divisions that consider the level of player and parent wishes to ensure a positive experience for both the player and parent.

ASSESSMENT TIMELINES

- There are no player assessments or evaluations for this level of play. Our Club philosophy is to develop every child within the program and provide opportunities for all players to play competitively if they wish.
- Our Competitive Teams will play at the Tier 2 or 3 Level.
- When selecting the Tier for the Indoor Season we will consider historical data, performance and results in our most recent season and prior knowledge of the players registered in the program.

DEADLINES

Team Entry

- October 1, 2025 is our deadline to enter teams into the league. We will register teams based on the registrations we have by September 15.

Roster Deadline

- There is a minimum roster number of 10 players per team. We will submit our initial rosters on October 10.

Late Registrations

- If there is space on a roster, players can register late and join the team.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT TIMELINES & TEAM FORMATION

OUTLINE

The purpose of the Player and Team Assessments is to determine the readiness of individual players to participate in the Program, and to determine the overall level of group for the Indoor Season. The goal of Team Entry in the Indoor Season will be to both challenge the team and to ensure meaningful competition.

ASSESSMENT TIMELINES

- All new PDP registrants will be invited to join Fall PDP Sessions to assess level of play within a regular session.
- Technical Staff will determine if a player is at the level of play required for the PDP program.
- Team Assessments to determine Tier Entry into CMSA for the Indoor Season will be determined by September 16. We will use historical data, as well as seeking input from existing coaches, players and parents.

DEADLINES

Team Entry

- October 1, 2025 is our deadline to enter teams into the league. We will register teams based on the registrations we have received by September 14.

Roster Deadline

- There is a minimum roster number of 10 players per team. We will submit our initial rosters on October 10.
